



Enhanced participation of migrants by setting up migrant internal councils

Partners from Bulgaria, France, Romania, Greece, Hungary and Italy met on the 14th of November 2022 for a study visit in Graz, Austria.

The aim of the project is to involve refugees and migrants in the formulation and implementation of integration policies and related measures at the local, regional and national level. Furthermore, sessions of observation and learning best practices from an already functional Migrants Council have been part of the event's agenda.

Discussed topics:

- local integration policy and cooperation with the Migrant Advisory Council
- best practices of consultative bodies
- the foundation of the Migrant Advisory Council in Graz
- best practice guides and the further process of setting up migrant systems

The event included visits to 2 migrant-led organizations part of the Council:

Ridna Domivka Association - activities dedicated to Ukrainian living in Graz

Fivestones Association - activities dedicated to the Afghan community in Graz.
