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## THE TRAINING SESSIONS

On May 12 and 13, as part of the ENFEM project, training sessions for international women and local actors will be implemented. On the mornings of the 12th and 13th of June, all local actors engaged in international integration strategies will exchange best practices and determine which Romanian best practices can be raised. In addition, they will have the opportunity to gain a deeper understanding of how diversity management operates in the field of international citizen integration.

In the second half of the day, beginning at 5:00 p.m., international women are invited to two training sessions to learn about the legal employment system in Romania, as well as how to develop a network that will give them an advantage in the employment process. The four training sessions will take place in a hybrid format, connecting over twenty local actors and fifty international women from Cluj.

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
